

FULL-TIME GROUNDSMAN POSITION AT THE GUARDIAN'S RESTING PLACE

The National Spiritual Assembly would like to invite friends who have skills and experience with gardening and outdoor maintenance to apply for the Groundsman position at the Guardian's Resting Place in New Southgate Cemetery, London.

This position, becoming open from December 2021, will require the applicant to be a UK national, or have residence and a work permit, and either be located or be prepared to relocate to within close proximity of New Southgate Cemetery in North London.

The duties of the Groundsman include gardening, weeding, outdoor cleaning, and attending to the upkeep of memorials within the site. Successful applicants must be able to systematically plan and organise their tasks, taking full responsibility for caring for the site, and need to be willing to work as required in inclement weather. The applicant should also know—or would need to learn—how to operate power tools. A love for the outdoors and a focused work ethic would be very welcome.

The Guardian's Resting Place is a uniquely sacred site in the UK, visited by Bahá'ís from around the world. The privilege to serve here is both a spiritual responsibility and a blessing.

A salary is offered to enable the successful applicant to carry out this service. As with all service to the Faith, there is also the opportunity to undertake it on a voluntary or part-voluntary basis.
